Digital Presentation

You will need to research and write 5-7 sentences/bullets, in your own words, about the following subjects. You will also need to provide **citations** from which you gathered your information. You can have a Works Cited Page/Slide or list each cite at the bottom of each slide.

Must have first 4 topics and then pick another 3 to have 7 total!

- ❖ **1. Brief History:** When the country was created and what it was before it became an independent country.
- ❖ **2. Environment/Landscape:** Climate, Vegetation, Regions and weather patterns. (Seasonal)
- ❖ **3. Politics of Today:** What type of government does it have? (Dictatorship, Monarchy, Democratic Republic) Who is the head of state? (King, President, Prime Minister)
- ❖ **4. Economy:** The GDP. Unemployment. Type of currency. What do they import and export? With whom do they trade?

- ❖ Education: How long do people attend school? What kinds of schools are available? Costs and how they work?
- ❖ Religion: What is/are the dominant religion(s)? Why? Where does/do the religion(s) come from?
- ❖ Family: How large are families? What roles do the family members have? (Children and adults). Role of women?
- ❖ Cultural Traditions: Holidays? Dress? Food? Music?
- ❖ Recreation: What kinds of things do the people of this country do in their spare time? Sports?
